

Frequently Asked Questions for FCECCE

Q. What is the duration of the course?

A. The course comprises of six modules conducted over 4-6 months on a part-time basis. Trainees are required to complete 120 classroom hours and 60 practicum hours (Assessment on routine care and assistance in classroom delivery) - Supervised practicum: (Teaching practices: Pre-Practicum, Field work, Supervised Practicum and Post Practicum Reflections)

Q. What is the frequency and duration of lesson?

A. Lessons are held twice a week, between 2 to 3 hours each.

Q. What is the maximum allowed period for me to complete the course? If I am unable to complete it within the maximum allowed period, will I be entitled to any recourse or refund?

A. The maximum allowed period to complete the course is 6 months. Partial refund or recourse is possible, but subjected to approval from the Academic Board.

Q. What is the minimum entry requirement?

A. You are required to have completed GCE Sec 2 or equivalent to be eligible for enrolment.

Q. How is the course delivered and how will I be assessed?

A. The course is delivered through a variety of engaging and hands-on class activities which includes small and large group discussions, class projects, individual and/or group assignments, case studies and role-play sessions.

Trainees will be assessed based on individual or group assignments and class participation for every module in the Programme.

Q. Is there any funding support available for this course?

A. Government funding schemes are available via SkillsConnect and SkillsFuture for Singaporeans aged 25 years and above. Trainees are required to adhere to meeting the minimum attendance of at least 80% per module.

Approval of funding is subjected to submission of the documents and approval given at least 2 weeks before commencement of the course.

Q. What is the teacher to student ratio?

A: The ratio is 1:30.

Q. Besides the course fees, are there other fees payable?

A. A one-time registration fee of S\$60 is payable.



Q. Do you have a refund policy?

A. Our refund policy can be found in the Student Handbook issued to registered students.
